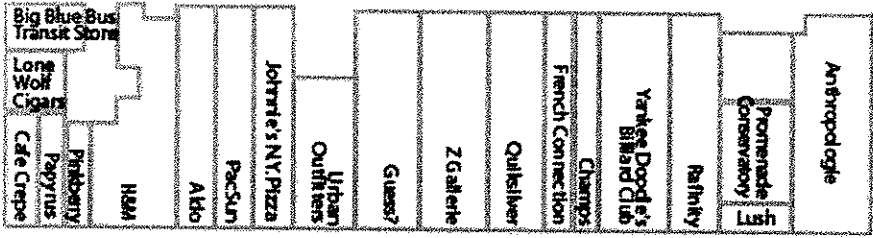
### Wednesday Night, Mar. 4<sup>th</sup> – Festival Check List/Items To Bring

- Study Materials and Additional Passive Activity

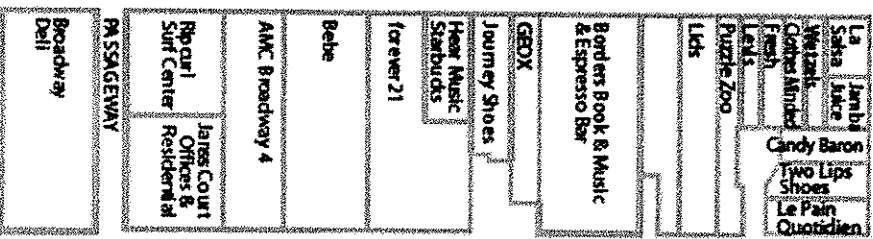
### Thursday, Mar. 5<sup>th</sup> – SCSBOA Festival @ Santa Monica High School

- 7:00 Concert Band busses leave Mira Costa**
- 7:45 Concert Band arrive at John Burroughs High School
- 7:50 Disembark Busses
  - Transfer instruments and concert clothes to Instrument Storage Room(s)
- 8:00 Concert Band into Warm-up Room
- 8:05 Symphonic Band begins loading bus, dressed in Concert Attire, checking in as you board

- 8:10 Symphonic Band bus leaves Mira Costa**
- 8:30 Concert Band Performs on Stage**

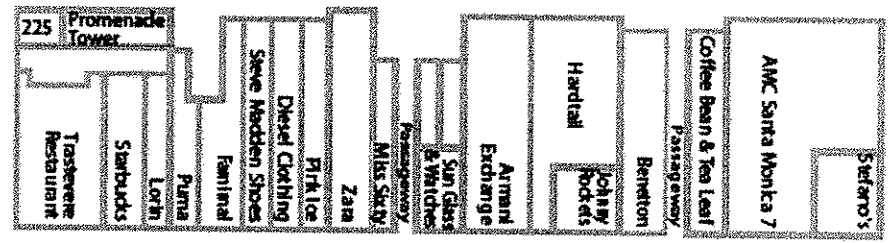

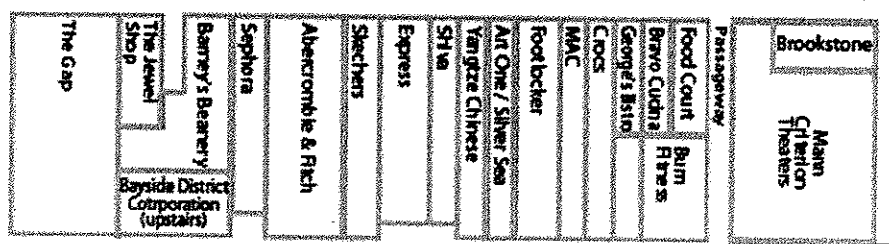

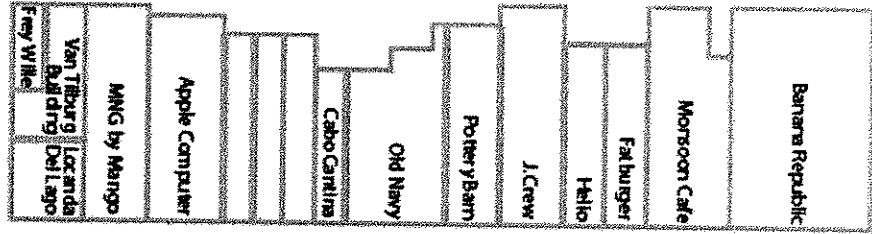


# PROMENADE THIRD STREET

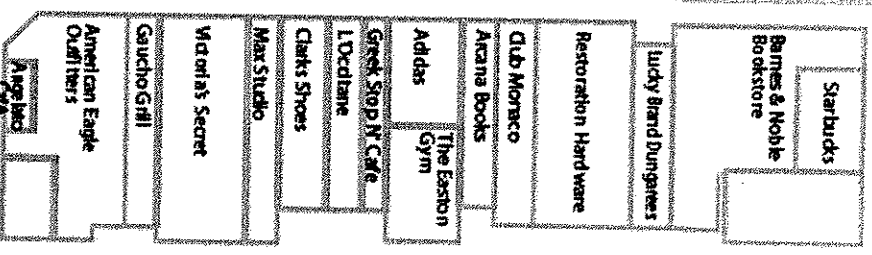

## SCSBOA District Festival Performance - Student Expectations and Information

---

### Safety & Conduct

- You are expected to stay on the Santa Monica High School Campus within a reasonable range of the performance hall, the instrument storage rooms, restrooms, sight-reading room, and concessions area
- You need to stay in a group of at least 2 people at all times.
- You are expected to adhere to all rules listed in the Mira Costa Student Code of Conduct.  
**Remember, we represent Mira Costa at all times.** Mira Costa's reputation depends on the individual decisions that you will make throughout the day.
- Consequences for rule violations are at the discretion of the Mr. Carlson and Mrs. Ruisinger and will include, but are not limited to: detention, suspension, band community service cleaning projects and more . . .
- Bottom Line: Let's have a safe, considerate, fun day.

### Checklist

- Failure to bring any of the items listed in the Festival Checklist at the top of the Schedule page (including *LONG BLACK DRESS SOCKS GENTLEMEN!*) will be deemed as an incorrect response to the matter of your preparations for performance and will count against your grade for the Festival Performance heavily.
- On the night before Festival, please make sure that you are ready to walk out the door the next morning with all the items on the list so that we can all have a more pleasant experience at Festival.

### Listening Opportunities and Requirements

- As musicians it is important that we both support our peers and think critically about both our own performance and the performances of others
- All Mira Costa students are required to attend all of the performances that it is possible for them to attend given by ensembles from Mira Costa, either as an audience member, or a performer.
- **IMPORTANT:** We must present our absolute best presence as audience members. It is our duty and privilege as musicians to adhere to strict concert etiquette. MAKE CERTAIN that your cell phones and ANY other electronic devices are turned off and REMAIN off during **ANY** time you are in the theater. Talking, whispering, or any sort of simple horseplay in the theater is strictly forbidden to the sophisticated audience member (AKA: **YOU**). Any disturbance of any performance will be considered an inappropriate response to the basic fundamentals of musicianship and will count against your grade for the Festival Performance heavily.

### Returning Home

- After your ensemble performs on stage you may change into street clothes, storing your concert attire near your instrument.
- After the Wind Ensemble performs on stage, we will begin making preparations to depart. The members of the Concert Band and Symphonic Band should gather all clothing, equipment and any additional items after the Wind Ensemble performs on stage and make their way back onto the buses. Once the Wind Ensemble rating has been posted, Wind Ensemble will load up, and we will depart.
